

ANNUAL ACTIVITIES REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2023-2024

Ashadip Medical and Social Welfare Association a popular name in the field of Social Welfare organization(NGO), is a Registered NGO is operational in all West Bengal state, is operational since 2005, let by highly qualified, enthusiastic professionals and incorporated with a vision to provide quality products, quality services, quality lifestyle and social Reorganization to its associates.

The activities carried during the year 2023-2024 are as below:-

MOBILE FREE MEDICAL CAMPS:

The Society has been organized Free General Health check-up & Eye screening camps, Free ECG, Free Spectacle Distribution, Free Blood Sugar Testing Camp at Vill+P.O-Kundalpal, P.S Sabang, Dist





Paschim Medinipur, Pin 721140 Dated 26/12/2023. Trained & Qualified Doctors & Medical Technical Staffs are screening the patients. In 2023-2024 season the Society has managed 2 numbers of General Health





& Eye screening camp where 230 numbers of patients were screened, provided free medicine and consultation there as much as possible from our end. The Society has spent a sum of Rs. 2,51,070.00 for Eye Screening and sum of Rs 2,88,380.00 for General Health Check-up during the year. The enthusiasm









of the people in all these medical camps was palpable. We provide a lot of people with completely free Treatment as well as various Tests completely free of cost. Such as E.C.G, Blood Pressure, Blood Sugar measurement and weight monitoring. 35 Patients are given Spectacles completely free of cost and Medicines are provided free of charge.

FREE CATARACT OPERATION CAMPS:

On 26th December 2023, the Free Eye Examination camp has become a cataract surgery camp. In the





said camp, four patients underwent cataract surgery completely free of cost with the help of our organization. The operation took place at Rotary Eye Hospital in West Midnipur District of







West Bengal. Along with the operation free of cost to the patients, necessary Medicines, Eye Glasses, and lenses required during the cataract operation are also provided free of charge. Renowned Ophthalmologist Dr. Manas Maiti was in charge of conducting the eye examination camp completely. He gave thorough eye examination and necessary medical advice to every patient who came to the entire camp. Even the cost of transportation from hospital to home is also borne by our organization. These operations were performed by Kundalpal villagers Tukal Hasda, Gorachand Bera, Danish Kha, and the wife of the celestial Haripada Patra. I can see these four people well, in a word, they are good.

SOUVENIR PUBLICATION & SEMINAR:-

A souvenir was released by our organization on 27th February 2024. In this souvenir, various projects





of the NGO are published and various information is published which will be useful for the life of the

NGO. A conference was held on this occasion throughout the day. The conference which was held was rich in information related to the project and about 40 NGOs attended the conference.







Representatives of NGOs from the distant state of Jharkhand and from the state of Arunachal Pradesh were present alongwith various reputedNGOs of West Bengal.

MATRI PAKSHA UTSAV:- SITTING DRAWING COMPETITION

Last February 27, 2024 on the occasion of Matri Paksha Utsav, our organization along with various other multi-purpose programs organized a sitting drawing competition to showcase the talent of local







children. 22 contestants participate in this competition. Each participating competitor is given a participation certificate by the organization and grade certificates are given separately to the first, second and third place winners.

MATRI PAKSHA UTSAV:- DANCE COMPETITION

On February 27, 2024, a Dance competition was held in Kundalpal Village under Sabang police station with talented artists in area dance. A total of Twenty contestants participated in the competition.

Candidates are identified as suitable for Blood Donation by thorough Examination of body weight, Blood pressure and other physical problems. Medical College Hospital of Paschim Medinipur district conducted Blood Bank in charge of conducting the said camp. Experienced doctors and Technical Medical team from Medinipur Medical College Hospital Blood Bank were present. Each person who





attended as a donor was given a T-Shirt for men and a saree for wo<mark>men bearing the Organization's</mark>

Logo.

Lunch was also organized at noon, and tiffin, coffee, horlicks were given to every donor. Donors are also given separate certificate and blood group test report from Medinipur Medical College Hospital Blood Bank. Also on behalf of the organization we give each one a memento and certificate. The blood donation camp starts at 10 am and ends at 1 pm. Our organization spent a total of Rs 61510/- in this sector during this financial year.

UTKARSAH BANGLA YOJANA ASSESSMENT

On 29th February 2024 and 31st February 2024, the last two batches of tailoring were tested in the training of tailoring and call center which has been going on for the last three years under Utkarsh







Bangla Yojana. This scheme has been completed with great success under the Government of West Bengal. All the unemployed youth who have taken training in this scheme are either doing business











themselves or working under a company. There are plans to increase such employment-oriented steel education in the future.

MOTHER PARTY FESTIVAL :- COOCKING COMPETITIONS

Last October 14th to 16th October 2023, Our Organization organized Matripaksha Utsav for three consecutive days. A multifaceted program was organized in the Festival. For example, Women's cooking competition, Dance program and Dance







competition etc. are significant. As part of the Festival, various NGOs from outside West Bengal including West Bengal attended the Project Oriented Seminar. The seminar runs throughout the day

and an informative Magazine is published. Also in the festival there is Football Competition between





eight teams throughout the day and Volleyball competition between six Teams at night. Also, in the Festival, more than fifty elderly people of the area are welcomed and provided with lunch. And dhoti lungis(Dress) are given as gifts.

SOCIAL EXPO

Kharagpur Local Police Station. Honorable Bablu Manik is currently appointed as the Secretary of the said NGO. Honorable Bablu Manik arranged education for hundreds of orphans in the said NGO. There also we program a short introductory episode. Children are provided with some soft drinks and food.
